**Minutes:**

COUNCILMAN BARLOW asked if this item contemplates park fees and CITY MANAGER ELIZABETH FRETWELL said it does not. He asked about medical marijuana and liquor and CITY MANAGER FRETWELL said that this is the business impact statement that accompanies a bill that will be considered at the next meeting. This is about a consolidation of a series of

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business licenses, updating that series and updating some fees that are all related to Business Licensing. She said there is a change to alcohol in it, but the right time to have the conversation is at the public hearing about the nature of that bill. This is just to notify and incorporate by reference, the responses staff received from businesses that would be impacted by these changes. CITY MANAGER FRETWELL confirmed for COUNCILMAN BARLOW that there are no medical marijuana fees in this bill.

CITY MANAGER FRETWELL said that related item 42 is the New Bills, is scheduled to be read today and referred to the Recommending Committee meeting on June 16, 2014.
