Minutes:

MAYOR GOODMAN invited DAVID BOWERS, Director of Public Works, to recognize September's ACTION Team from the City's Water Pollution Control Facility. These employees work every day to ensure that sewer water is cleaned to the highest standards before it is placed back into Lake Mead. This public service is key to the health and welfare of the entire Las Vegas Valley. The Mayor remarked that recently two teams of employees from the Water Pollution Control Facility traveled to St. George, Utah, to compete in a challenge that put teams against each other to work their way through obstacles commonly faced in treatment plants. Despite the disadvantage of not having many operators, the Las Vegas teams persevered and were voted to have the best sportsmanship by the other teams. The Mayor acknowledged each team member and presented them with a certificate.

DAVID BOWERS, Public Works Director, stated that this is a very deserving team who represented the City well. He thanked the team members for their sportsmanship and also thanked the City Council for the recognition.
