**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**

This bill, intended to complement the proposed licensing regulations pertaining to mobile car wash/auto detail businesses, would generally prohibit the washing of vehicles upon public streets and rights-of-way. Consistent with current environmental regulations, an exception is made for the noncommercial washing of personal vehicles in front of or near a private driveway under specified circumstances. The primary purpose of the measure is to assist the City in protecting its stormwater system and related State-issued permits, as well as helping conserve and preserve precious water resources.
