PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

Consultant services include design and preparation of contract drawings and special provisions for sidewalk improvements to include constructing sidewalk in areas where there is none, ADA ramps and other improvements. Award of this contract is recommended by the City of Las Vegas consultant selection committee. Funding for this project is provided by a Community Development Block Grant for Fiscal Year 2014-2015. The City shall complete all HUD-required Environmental Reviews (ER). No project may commit and/or expend any funds prior to compliance with 24 CFR Part 58 and final notification. Should there be an increase or decrease in funding amounts, awards shall be changed proportionately. This item is exempt from the competitive process pursuant to NRS 332.115.1 (b) Professional Services. Kimley-Horn and Associates is located in Las Vegas, Nevada.
