PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

This Resolution will ratify the adoption of the Southern Nevada Strong Regional Plan, as adopted by the Southern Nevada Regional Planning Coalition. This plan replaces the Regional Policy Plan adopted in 2012 as the regional planning document for Southern Nevada. The Southern Nevada Strong Regional Plan represents the efforts of an unprecedented planning process, a process which reached tens of thousands of people who shared their vision of the future. The plan ratified by this resolution satisfies the requirements of NRS 278.02528.
