MAYOR GOODMAN and COUNCILMEMBERS BARLOW, BEERS, and ROSS announced the various events taking place in their respective Wards on various dates throughout the month of February. COUNCILMAN BARLOW further announced that Coffee with the Councilman will be cancelled for the month of May. He congratulated MAYOR GOODMAN, COUNCILWOMAN TARKANIAN and COUNCILMAN COFFIN for winning their re-election in the primary.

COUNCILWOMAN TARKANIAN congratulated COUNCILMAN BARLOW on his re-election in the primary as well. She announced that Ward 1 is looking for Park Ambassadors to promote upcoming City events and meet and greet the public using the parks. Those interested can call her office at 229-2299. She invited neighborhoods to apply for grants via the Neighborhood Partners Fund Program, which provides funding opportunities for residents to generate resolutions to critical neighborhood issues. He stated that the State Department has given the City a grant to make available six-month passes to injured veterans to get involved in recreational programs that have been customized specifically for them.
