

CONTRACT MODIFICATION NO. 1
Public Attorney Services The Kice Law Group, LLC

THIS MODIFICATION NO. 1 is being entered into this _____ day of _____, 2015, by and between the CITY OF LAS VEGAS (hereinafter, "City"), a municipal corporation within the State of Nevada having its principal office at 495 S. Main Street, Las Vegas, Nevada 89101, and THE KICE LAW GROUP, LLC (hereinafter, the "Company"), a Nevada Limited Liability Company (LLC) having its principal office at 324 S. Third Street, Suite 1, Las Vegas, Nevada 89101.

The purpose of the Modification is to extend the performance period of the Contract for one (1) year, and provide for two (2) optional one-year renewal terms.

The Contract between the City and the Company dated July 24, 2013 is hereby modified as follows:

1. PARAGRAPH B-5: Performance Period

REFERENCE: Paragraph B-5, (a)

DELETE: In its entirety.

REPLACE WITH: The performance period commences July 1, 2013 and continues through June 30, 2016, unless extended through mutual agreement of the parties hereto.

2. PARAGRAPH B-5: Performance Period

REFERENCE: Paragraph B-5, (b)

DELETE: In its entirety.

REPLACE WITH: The Contract is renewable, upon mutual consent, for two (2) additional one (1) year periods based on performance evaluation under the direction of the Court Administrator. The City shall give the Attorney/Law Firm ninety (90) days written notice of intent to renew the Contract. The Attorney/Law Firm shall give the Contract Administrator at least one hundred twenty (120) days written notice of its intent not to renew the Contract. If the Attorney/Law Firm desires to terminate this Contract during its term, written notice of that intent shall be given to the City at the earliest possible time in order to facilitate transition of legal representation of the Indigent Defendant to a new attorney. If the Attorney/Law Firm fails to give the one hundred twenty days (120) written notice of its decision not to renew the Contract as required herein, and such failure results in additional expense to the City in retaining a replacement attorney, the City shall be entitled to deduct the additional expense from the unpaid compensation due to the Attorney/Law Firm, and any balance remaining thereafter shall be paid to the Attorney/Law Firm, or in the event of any deficiency exists thereafter, the deficiency shall be paid by the Attorney/Law Firm within thirty (30) days after a receipt of an invoice from the City.

2. GENERAL

In the event of any conflict between the Contract and this modification, the provisions of Modification No. 1 take precedence. All other contract terms and conditions remain unchanged.
