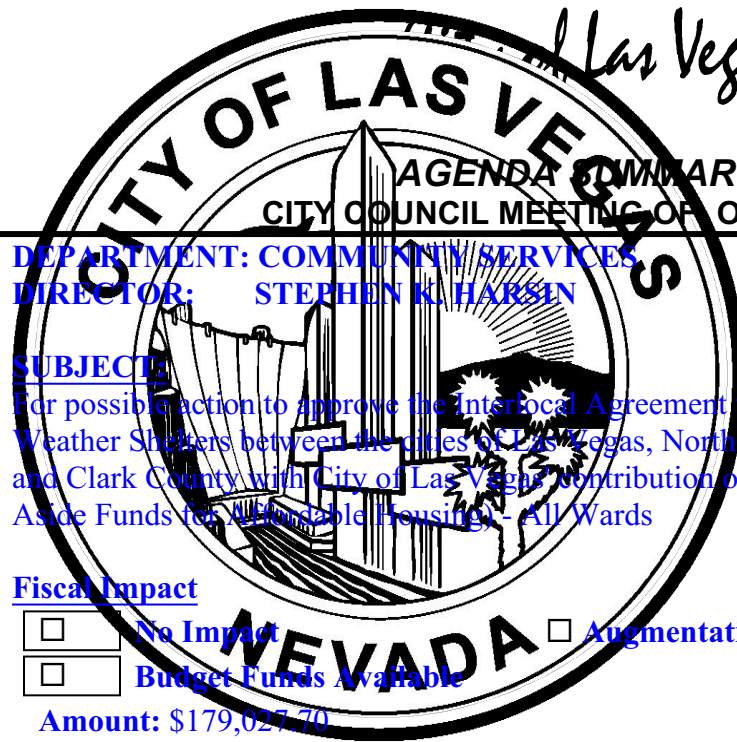

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The Interlocal Agreement provides \$596,759.00 in shared funding for FY 2015-16 specifically for supporting the operations of homeless shelters in Southern Nevada. All local jurisdictions contribute on a population-based formula. The city of Las Vegas proportionate share is \$179,027.70. These funds are used to fund the weather shelter program administered by Catholic Charities, Salvation Army, Shade Tree and Hope Link of Southern Nevada. The funding helps to support approximately 310 to 325 homeless individuals with shelter throughout the year. The regional partners include Clark County and the cities of Las Vegas, Henderson, North Las Vegas and Boulder City.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends the Mayor and Council to approve the interlocal agreement and authorizes the Mayor to execute any and all related documents approved as to form by the City Attorneys Office.
