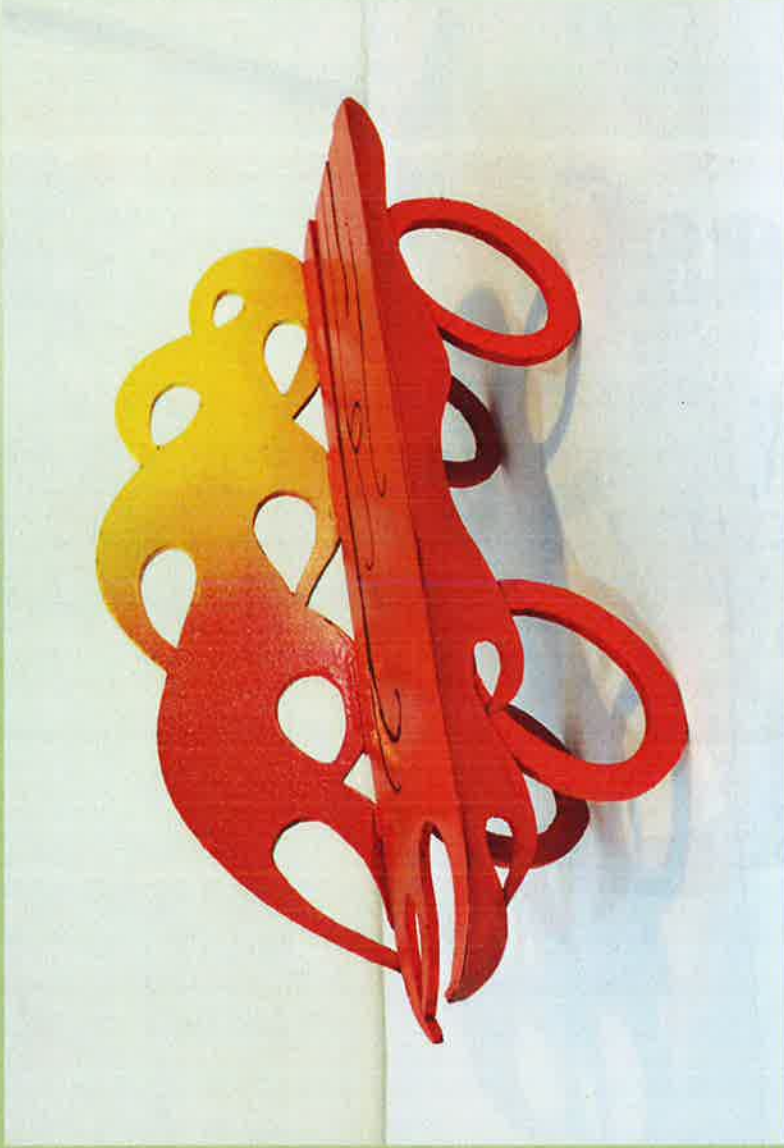
- Fabricated in Las Vegas
- Steel construction comparable to the benches currently purchased by the city; powdercoat or epoxy painted surface
- Engineered by Nevada-licensed engineer
- Built with attention to durability, safety & maintenance concerns (no sharp edges or corners etc.)
- Will provide comfortable seating for short term use (but not long term)

- Seven preliminary concepts presented here; to be edited down to five, two selected for Phase I and tree guard designs
- Themes: the vibrant city & built environment, the beauty of the desert landscape, the dynamic entertainment industry
- Goals: to enliven the downtown visual environment, to provide comfortable short term seating, to add artwork of the highest quality to the public art collection of Las Vegas

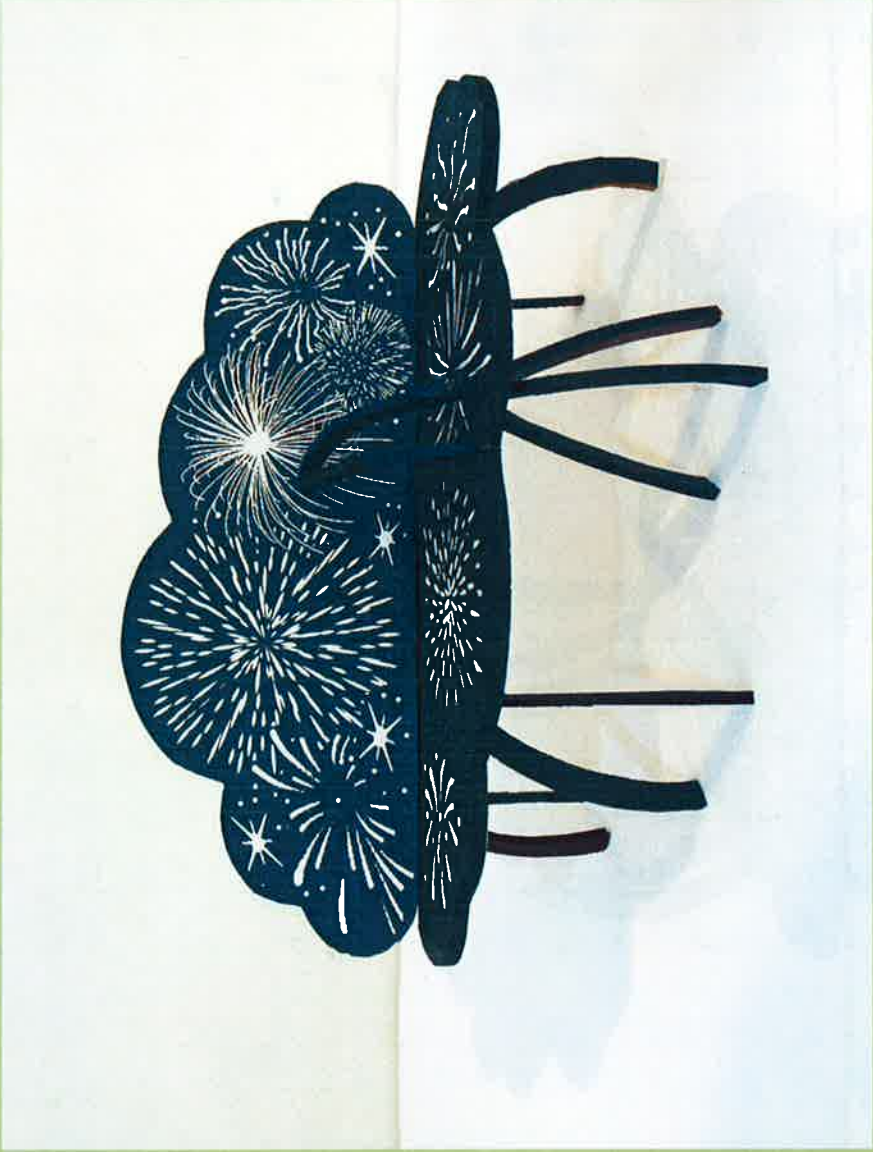
