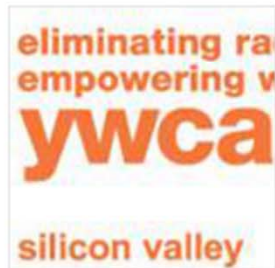

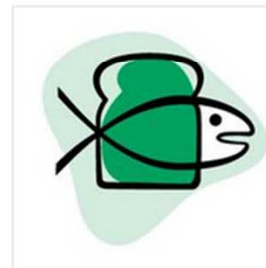

How will JustServe work for you?

1. Register on JustServe.org then search for a project in your area. Click “volunteer.” Then go have fun!
2. Identify a project: When you see an opportunity for service, submit the project for approval at **JustServe.org/aboutus/**
3. Once approved, your project will be placed on the website for volunteers to see.

JustServe matches churches, civic organizations, non-profits, and governmental agencies that need volunteers with volunteers willing to help. JustServe.org links you to service opportunities in your community so you can make a difference wherever you are and however you want to serve.
