The **Doolittle Senior Center Community Gardens**, 1200 Blankenship Ave., recently received the award of excellence as the 2015 Southern Nevada Landscape award winner. The award of excellence is the highest honor earned in the Southern Nevada Landscape Awards. Winners of the award demonstrate superior design skill and a mastery of landscape and gardening practices. For 10 years, University of Nevada Cooperative Extension Master Gardener **Don Fabbi** has been coordinating and educating the gardeners, volunteers and neighboring residents at the community gardens. The center's gardens were described by judges as "big and beautiful" and "clearly a labor of love." The garden is celebrating its 20th anniversary.

The Henderson Chamber of Commerce recently announced nominees for the 16th annual Economic Development and Small Business Awards, naming **HopeLink of Southern Nevada** among the top three nominees from a field of 74 members in the category for Outstanding Non-Profit in 2015. **Habitat for Humanity** and **Spread the Word Nevada** were also named in the category, awards for which are set to be announced at the Nov. 19 gala at Green Valley Ranch. The Nevada Arts Council selected eight Nevada artists to receive 2016 Artist Fellowship funding. Four artists were awarded FY16 Artist Fellowships Grants of \$5,000, three artists the Fellowship honorable mention awards of \$500, and one artist the Artist Fellowship Project Grant of \$7,000. The fellowship recipients are: **Erik Burke**, painting, Reno; **Gig De Pio**, painting, Las Vegas; **Justin Favela**, sculpture, Las Vegas; and **David Rowe**, sculpture, Las Vegas. Honorable mention recipients are: **Dean Burton**, photography, Reno; **Nate Clark**, painting, Reno; and **Nick Larsen**, mixed media, Reno. The project grantee is **Joseph DeLappe**, digital media, Reno.

In September, State Treasurer **Dan Schwartz** and the Board of Trustees of the College Savings Plans of Nevada announced that Nevada State College senior **Tobias Torres** has been selected as the Southern Nevada recipient of the 2015 **Kenny C. Guinn Memorial Scholarship**.

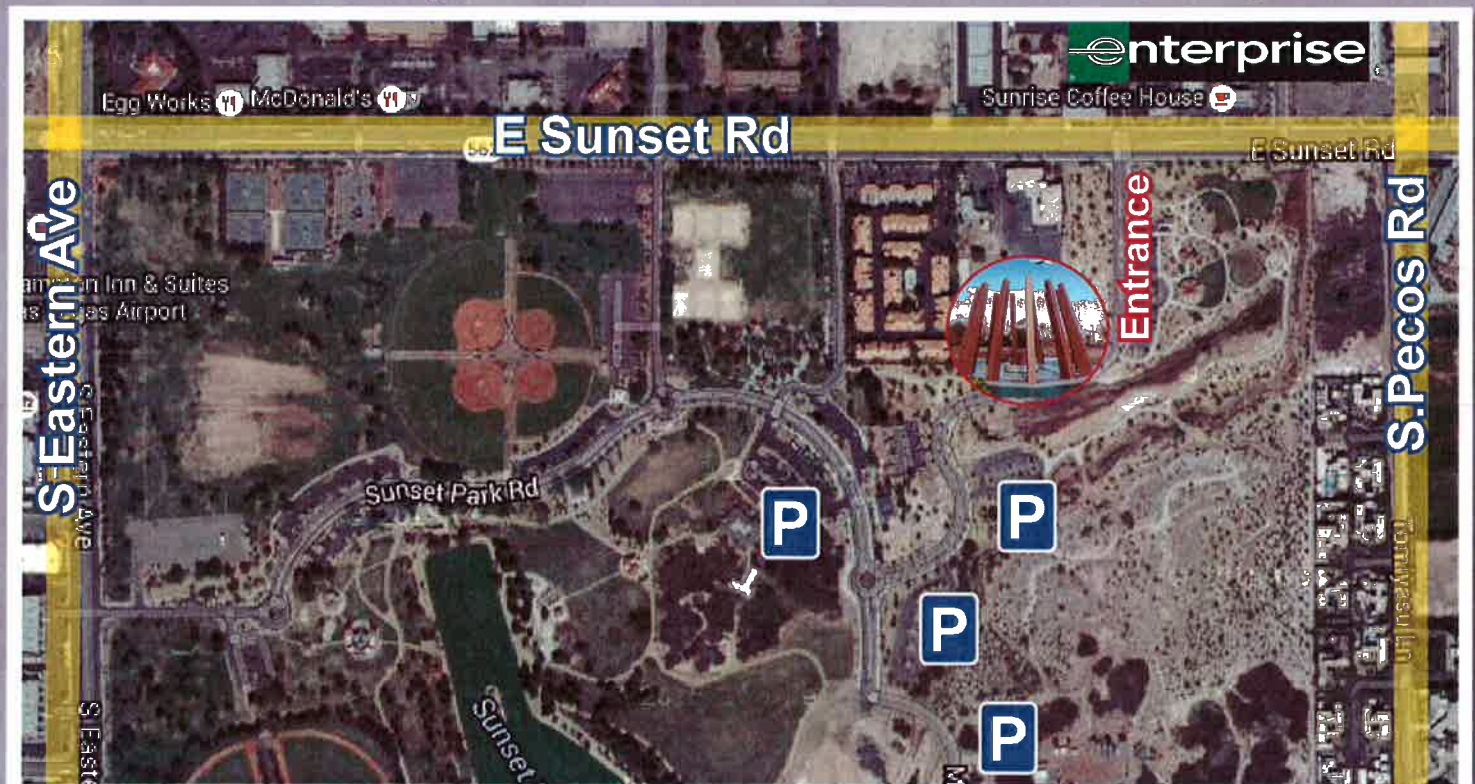
