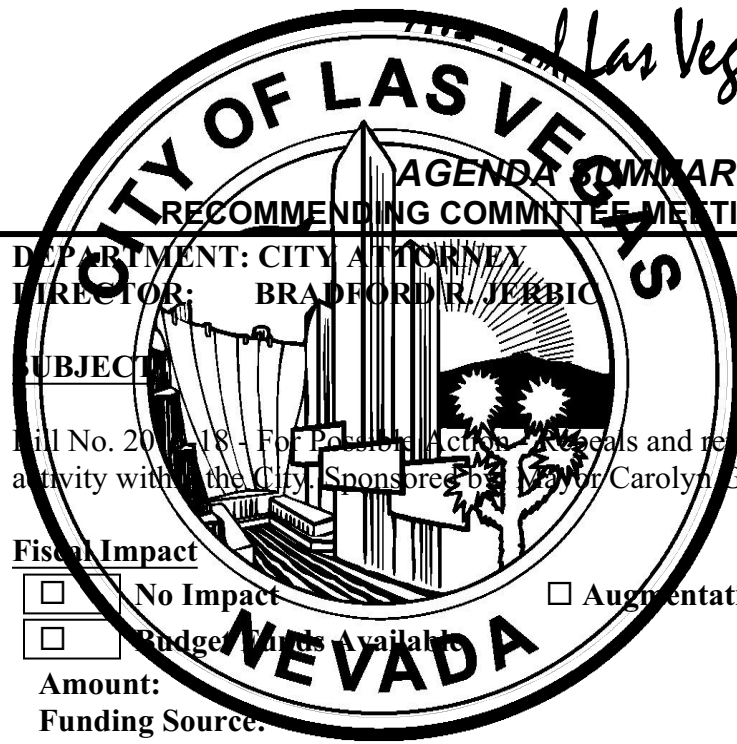

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

This bill will repeal and replace provisions relating to filming activity within the City. Current provisions on the subject are out of date and inadequate to address all issues that arise. The provisions of the proposed ordinance largely reflect the City's current practice and philosophy regarding filming activity.

COUNCILMAN BARLOW declared the Public Hearing open.

DAVID BOWERS, Director of Public Works, stated that this bill cleans up the filming activity code, replacing Title 11, Chapter 56 with Title 12, Chapter 4. This bill defines all of the elements associated with filming activity and what the requirements are. A business impact statement was sent to those affected by this bill; three comments were received regarding concerns about some of the parameters.
