Minutes:

COUNCILMAN ROSS declared the Public Hearing open.

DAVID BOWERS, Director of Public Works, described the Alta Drive Landscape Maintenance District for Fiscal Year 2017 as containing 37 parcels between Rancho Drive and Lacy Lane. The Special Improvement District (SID) was created in 2002 and that it is assessed on an area basis. The SID covers the cost of landscape maintenance, public utilities and plant attrition from July 2016 through June 2017. He stated that the assessment remains unchanged from the previous year at \$75,800. There have been no written protests filed with the City Clerk's Office.

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COUNCILMAN ROSS declared the Public Hearing closed.
