2/15/18 – Efforts underway to restore the paint on the Atomic Passage benches along Casino Center, including the removal of the existing paint, possibly re-sealing the concrete and then reapplying both the white paint and anti-graffiti coating; to investigate reactivating the planter portion of the benches as well (est. cost TBD).

12/21/17 – Artists received first check as per contract deliverables. Their drawings must now be stamped by a Nevada Licensed Professional Engineer to receive the next payment.

10/19/17, 11/16/17 – Artists are developing the finalized lighting plan for the project.

9/21/17 – *Queen of the Arts* by Gus & Lina Ocamposilva, has been selected for the project. Post award conference was held on 9/5/17 to discuss next steps. Their first deliverable includes a detailed project schedule.
