For possible action to approve award of First Amendment to Contract No. 160015-JH, Prime Design Services Contract for Sewer Rehabilitation Group A located on Sandhill Road, Charleston Boulevard, Broadalbin Drive, Wyoming Avenue and Arden Street between Bonanza Road and Sahara Avenue - Department of Public Works - Award recommended to: BLACK & VEATCH (\$69,014 - Sanitation Enterprise Fund) - Ward 3 (Coffin)

**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**

On August 19, 2015 the subject contract was awarded by City Council for professional engineering services for repair or replacement of approximately 7,400 feet of 33, 45, and 51 inch sewer pipe and approximately eleven manholes. The project also includes a practicable scheme for diversion and/or temporary bypass pumping of sewage during construction, flow monitoring and a review of the previous assessment to validate rehabilitation quantities. This amendment provides design for removal and replacement of pipeline sections, additional flow monitoring and permitting assistance for NPDES de minimis groundwater discharge permits.
