To whom it may concern,

As a frequent traveler to Las Vegas for tradeshow over the last 30 years – we started using off strip short term rental housing over 10 years ago for a variety of reasons:

- 1) traditional hotels stopped offering value well over a decade ago with the staggering run-up in pricing (prior to 2008-9 crash).
- 2) Friday/Saturday – peak pricing was egregious
- 3) Internet services are still lack lustre and over-priced
- 4) For those of us that are non-smokers – we were forced to walk through toxic casino environments to access our rooms or facilities.
- 5) While room rates have dropped – food/beverage costs in any hotel have sky rocketed for what is, as a whole, marginal quality at best

Off strip short term rental housing provides a far cleaner and more productive environment for those of us coming to Las Vegas on business. Particularly with larger support staffs for the following reason:

- 1) multi bedroom homes at reasonable rates
- 2) on-site laundry facilities for longer stays (due to airline limits – we can pack for 5 days – even though our trips are usually 9-10 days)
- 3) restive and relaxed environment for business meetings – free of smoke and gambling
- 4) significant savings on food and beverage expenses
- 5) high speed internet without daily limits (most hotels limits are laughable)
- 6) free overnight parking

I could list a multitude of reasons more why we support short term rentals in Las Vegas. I find it very unfortunate that this city council would even consider any type of limit on the same. Home owners should be free to legally do with their property what they choose.

It would appear that those casino robber-barons do not like competition that offers much better value than they could ever hope to offer. Support the people – not billionaire casino owners.

REGULATIONS RELATED TO SHORT TERM RESIDENTIAL RENTALS

We have chosen to provide remarks regarding this proposed amendment, we hope you will review and consider them.

My name is Jason Cohen, I am an owner and 100% operator/manager of a licensed short term rental in Las Vegas, NV. I have reviewed the proposed amendments in detail, and strongly believe that some of the items (not all) will negatively impose a direct and significant economic burden on my business, as well as restrict the ongoing operation of my business (I will only focus on those items in my remarks).

The proposed amendment to "obtain a 'Special Use Permit', (even to existing 'Short Term Rental Operators' who have a business licensed with the City of Las Vegas)"

My understanding is that in order to get approved for 'Special Use Permit', the neighbors must get involved and 'approve' the neighboring 'short term rental business'. This poses a great risk, as the 'media' has already categorized 'ALL' 'Short Term Rental's' as "Party Houses", and there is a misconception about what Short Term Rentals are*. Neighbors are more inclined to say 'No' to this type of business, if given a choice. This opportunity to involve a neighbor is not fair, as it would potentially result in restricting and shutting down of our 'short term rental' business, not because of the house itself, but rather, the fact that the media negatively portrays 'Short Term Rental' business in Las Vegas. (The President Stephen Gorgan of Scotch 80s neighborhood calling it an 'Epidemic' published in the 'LV Review Journal', as an example)**. There is a misconception about what 'Short Term Rental' business is,.....most our guests are family coming to town for a sports tournament, as an example, others would agreed this is the primary force behind this type of travel***. We were given a license with the City of Las Vegas with conditions, all of which we have followed, whereby we do not allow for 'parties', 'wedding's, max of 12 occupancy, 4 bedroom max size home, and have had excellent visitors to our home who treat both the home and neighbors as if it was theirs. We believe in the current conditions to govern a successful 'short term rental', but believe it is UNFAIR to require an 'existing' owner and operator of a short term rental house who already has a business license with the City of Las Vegas to have to go

through the process of a 'Special Permit', the existing Business License with conditions governs it already.

Those who have an existing license with current conditions in place, should NOT have to obtain a 'Special Permit'. If they are not following the conditions they should lose their license. It is not fair nor does it make sense to make a current owner/operator of a 'Short Term Rental' business with a business license to have to go through this process proposed, the proposed ordinance is 'one sided' and poses a huge threat to the 'Short Term Rental' market in Las Vegas. Successful operators of Short Term Rental business employ local house cleaners, gardeners, maintenance, Internet/cable TV, security, etc. , and in addition make a disposable income to support their families and spend, which contribute the well being of our economy. In addition, the Lodging Tax Revenues accounts benefit from 'Short Term Rentals' , as an example, Washoe County adopted an ordinance permitting 'private rentals', which brings in about \$500,000 a year****. There should be more focus on 'compliance' with those existing licenses operators (if they are throwing parties), and to get those who are not licensed, to be licensed. This is a growing market and will not stop*****. Airbnb, one platform for advertising 'Short Term Rentals' has a valuation of 37 billion dollars, 2nd after the Marriot hotels, making it the 2nd largest valuation in the Lodging Industry, travellers will continue to find new ways to travel, lets embrace this, and govern it, NOT shut it down. The proposed 'special permit' poses a risk to ongoing business as well as economic burden.

Don't Motel Our Neighborhood!

PETITION IN FAVOR OF LAS VEGAS CITY COUNCIL
BILL # 2017-16

Dear Neighbors,

Councilwoman Lois Tarkanian has been working since 2008 to Strictly Regulate Short Term Rentals in the City of Las Vegas. Short Term Rentals are currently banned in Henderson, North Las Vegas and Clark County; however, they are not banned in the City of Las Vegas. Over the past years, she has had no support from City Council. Councilwoman Tarkanian is now working to PASS Bill #2017-16, which will allow YOU the voter to have a voice as to the direction of Short Term Rentals in your neighborhoods.

Bill #2017-16 will tighten existing rules and regulations for Short Term Rentals by making applicants apply for a **Special Use Permit**. A Special Use Permit requires a notification be mailed to neighbors and a public hearing where you can voice your opinion on the application.

Currently, individuals who want to operate a Short Term Rental only need to apply for a business license. Neighbors are not notified of the business application. They are only made aware once the Short Term Rental Business is open and operating next door. The law as it currently exists, does not allow neighbors to have a voice as to the direction of the communities they make home. **Bill #2017-16 is working to give you a voice.**

ACT NOW and sign the attached petition. Please send one email to all email addresses listed at the top of the petition. It is important, *not only* the Councilman/woman in your WARD knows your position, but also **ALL** other Council Members as they are voting on behalf of us, the entire community. This will ensure that everyone will see who received your email.

TO BE CLEAR:

- We are not fighting against a home owner who wants to rent out a room in their home (that they live in) or operate as a true Bed & Breakfast.
- We are not fighting against a home owner who wants to rent/lease a home for a minimum of 30 days or more.
- **WE ARE** fighting against companies/individuals turning homes into **MOTELS** and letting tourists stay for 2-3 nights with no homeowner present. Tourists do not **LIVE** in Las Vegas and therefore it is **NOT** a residential activity. It is a business.

NOTES:

- **Expedia Inc.** – Owns Airbnb, Home Away and VRBO (vacation rentals by owner).
- AirBnB booked 340,000 room nights in Southern Nevada and made 45+ million dollars in 2016. This number does not include booked rooms or revenue made from VRBO or Home Away.
- Rooms booked on Airbnb, VRBO and Home Away do not have to pay the 12%-13% room tax that our hotel industry pays and puts back into our community that pay for code enforcement, schools, etc.
- Many of these operators are not collecting the 8.15% sales tax.
- Airbnb is expanding their business and is now hiring a Community Manager to oversee Las Vegas. See job posting from LinkedIn.
- Lobbyists (most likely hired by Expedia) have met and continue to meet with City Council members to change current zoning regulations, so they are more in favor of less regulation for short term rentals. Based on the nonchalant behavior to the commercialization of our neighborhoods... these lobbyists might be making progress. Campaign Contributions in an election year always help form an opinion.
- **San Francisco has implemented new regulations to try and protect and regulate the listings** and homeowners. Click to read.

Short Term Rentals are currently banned in Henderson, North Las Vegas and Clark County; however, they are not banned in the City of Las Vegas. - Rooms booked on Airbnb, VRBO and Home Away do not have to pay the 12%-13% room tax that our hotel industry pays and puts back into our community that pay for code enforcement, schools, etc.

I write in support of Las Vegas City Council Bill No. 2017-16 revising regulations and requirements pertaining to short-term residential rentals.

My State Senate District No. 3 is arguably the most impacted of all the political districts in Clark County. District No. 3 intersects three of your City Council wards, and I want to share my thoughts on concerns raised by my constituents.

Although approximately 155 business licenses for short-term rentals exist throughout the city, it is amazing to note that in my district alone, a recent survey shows there are a minimum of 75 known **unlicensed** short-term rentals found operating on commercial vacation rental websites. Additionally, estimates place approximately 400 **unlicensed** short-term rentals located within the city limits of Las Vegas.

I am sure you are aware of the main points of this issue, but the overriding factor is that none of the city's citizens have had input in the licensing process of short-term rentals. I find this unacceptable to our democratic process and, more importantly, to our way of life in a community that seeks to have harmonious neighborhoods. This is a zoning issue being abused. The original law was meant not to be an open grant allowing a business to operate uncontrolled in a residential neighborhood.

I have to be blunt. People who are operating short-term rentals are doing so for commercial purposes, for financial gains. Those renting their homes may plead a hardship case. My neighbors want to be proud of home ownership, raise their families in safe communities, and gain valuable home equity in the long-term investment they have made.

Under Bill No. 2017-16, short-term rentals are not banned outright, just better regulated. Business licenses will still be granted to those operating on a small scale. Party houses can operate but will be subject to acquiring a special use permit. This process provides neighbors an opportunity to offer public testimony on short-term rental operations in residential neighborhoods.

I challenge you as the elected representatives for the citizens of our great city to not be swayed by lobbyists whose interests are from out-of-state conglomerates, who want to merely turn our city into one large hotel resort. This does not sit well with my constituents who live, work, and play in Las Vegas.

From my position, I will act with city officials to find the support to improve code enforcement and rid Las Vegas of unlicensed commercial operations that do not pay city fees or lodging taxes developed to help cover our municipal service infrastructure. By not paying taxes the illegal operators do a disservice to our hospitality industry who use lodging revenues to pay salaries to deserving and hard-working people, who in turn pay their mortgages. All members of the short-term rental industry should be required to pay their share of city fees and taxes.

I have faith that you will make the right decision, knowing that Bill No. 2017-16 will be an improvement and a first step in allowing residential neighborhoods to continue to be made up of families and friends and not short-term strangers.

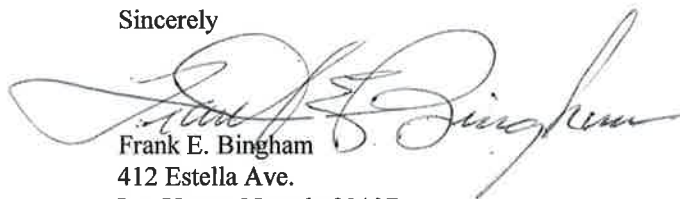

First, I would like to thank you and your family for your service to our community.

Regarding Bill 2017-16:

Bill 2017-16 is NOT an effective solution and should not be adopted.

I own a short term rental property (STR) in Las Vegas. The vast majority of STR properties are run very well and do not have any problems with their neighbors. Unfortunately, there have been a very small % of "party houses" or mis-managed properties, but these are rare exceptions and should be dealt with accordingly.

A better idea is to work with the STR industry to develop sensible solutions that work for everyone.

For example we use a new technology. Its an electronic noise monitor made specifically for STR properties. It sends us a text message if noise levels at the STR reaches a certain level. This allows us to contact our guests and solve the problem before they disturb the neighbors.

Ideas like this make sense for everyone. However Bill 2017-16 does not work for everyone especially with the stringent requirements for Special Use Permits (SUP). SUPs are very difficult, expensive and time consuming to obtain. According to the City, one has NEVER been granted for an STR.

The vacation rental industry provides an important service in Las Vegas that hotels and casinos do not offer. A family with grandparents and kids do not want to rent 5 or 6 hotel rooms and then hang out in the bar at night. They want to be able to relax and have dinner together, spend quality time together and not be forced to expose their children to a casino at night. Business groups that come for conventions feel the same way. It makes more sense for them to have their team all in one place so that after the convention day they can come back to a home and relax and talk about their day. There are also plenty of families that come to Vegas for a wedding on the strip and want to stay together in a home.

These groups that travel to Las Vegas would not come here if they had to rent hotel rooms. They will find other cities that provide what they want. These groups shop at local stores, go to local restaurants and provide good jobs for cleaning staff, maintenance, gardeners and other people that care for the home.
