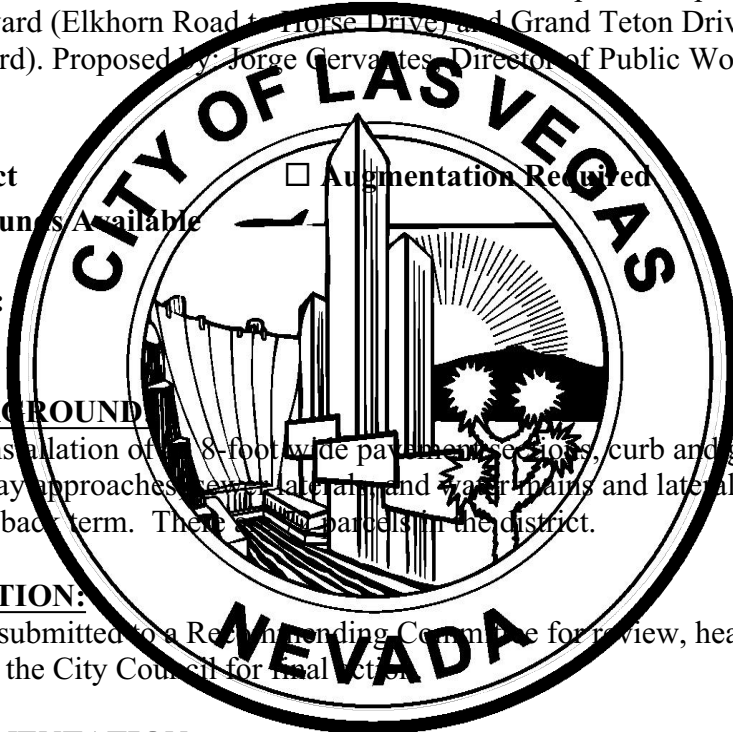

Construction and installation of 7-8-foot wide pavement sections, curb and gutter, sidewalk, streetlights, driveway approaches, lateral and water mains and laterals. This district will have a 20-year pay back term. There are 10 parcels in the district.
