PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

This bill will authorize a solid waste collection franchisee to charge certain fees pertaining to the recordation, maintenance and release of liens associated with solid waste collection services. The intent is to allow the franchisee to pass along to property owners certain costs incurred in connection with property liens imposed for nonpayment of collection fees. The bill is similar to ones recently adopted by Clark County and the City of Henderson.
