PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

This bill will update and consolidate various provisions governing special events and similar activities. Current regulations governing special events, parades, block parties, and other temporary events are scattered throughout the Municipal Code. As a result, those seeking to hold such events have been subject to a variety of processes across several departments and agencies. This bill is intended to simplify and speed up the process by which such events can be reviewed and approved, while retaining appropriate procedures and standards to ensure that the public interest is protected.

This bill should be submitted to a Recommending Committee for review, hearing and recommendation to the City Council for final action.
