Minutes:

MARIA and JOSE CALVINO, Mamacita's Restaurant on Fremont Street, expressed concern about mobile vendors and the proximity of their parking to brick and mortar restaurants. Recent attempts by the Planning Commission to limit vendors' proximity to restaurants has resulted in the vendors paying private property owners to use their space, and effectively circumventing the distance separation established by the Planning Commission. Parking is already a problem in this area and the mobile food vendors are taking business away from the existing restaurants in the area and are killing business at Mamacita's. The CALVINO'S stated they do not need or want the mobile food vendors in their area.

COUNCILMAN BARLOW received clarification from DEPUTY CITY ATTORNEY VAL STEED that the issue of mobile food vendors is not yet on the City Council agenda. COUNCILMAN BARLOW asked his assistant, YDOLEENA YTURRALDE, to keep the CALVINO'S updated on the status of this issue.

COUNCILMAN BARLOW announced that Bills 2012-12 through 2012-15 are eligible for adoption on March 21, 2011.
