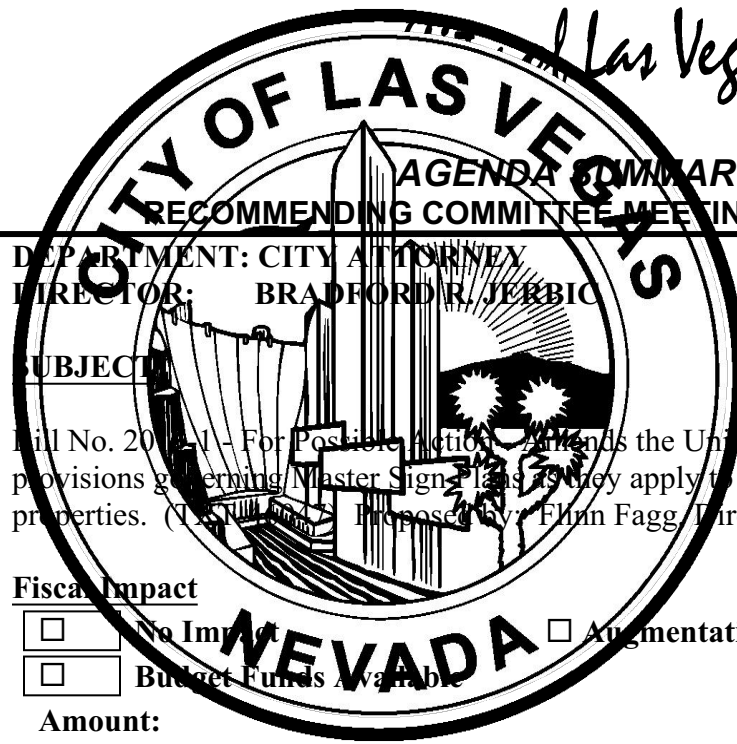

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

This bill will amend the Unified Development Code to revise the provisions governing Master Sign Plans as they apply to certain gaming and downtown properties. The purpose of the amendment is to clarify that the Master Sign Plan process need not be followed (and will not be available) for gaming and downtown properties whose signage is otherwise subject to a review process.
