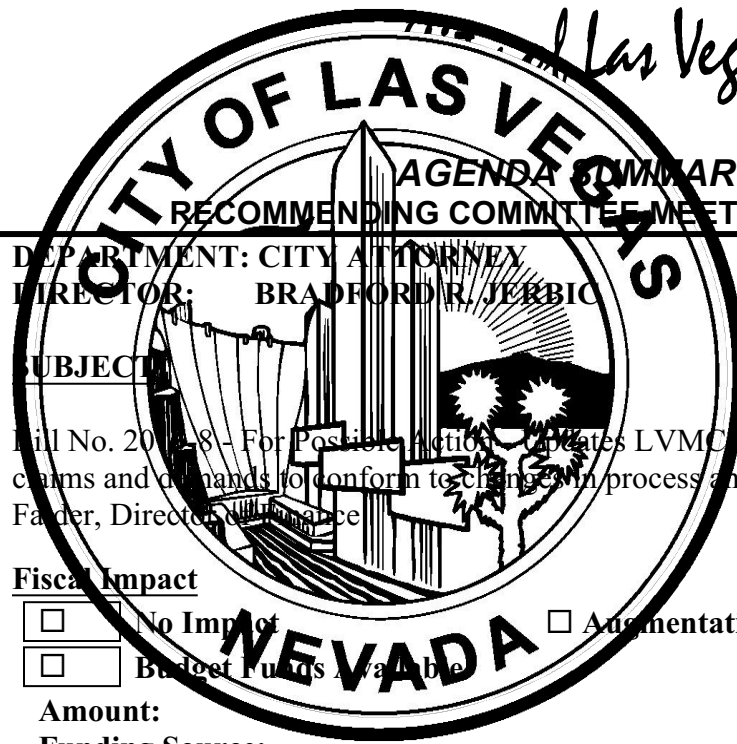

By way of reading the item, MAYOR GOODMAN declared the Public Hearing open.

DEPUTY CITY ATTORNEY VAL STEED explained that, in keeping with the Mayor's initiative of streamlining and reviewing the City's ordinances, this proposed bill will update processes and terminology contained in the current ordinance regarding payments and claims. He confirmed for MAYOR GOODMAN that there is still a mountain to climb in terms of the numbers of ordinances still needing to be reviewed.
