To whom it may concern:

TMO/Crown Castle as Agent, propose to modify the existing unmanned telecommunications facility located at 450 S. Buffalo Drive, APN # 138-34-201-001 in Las Vegas, NV. We are requesting a Special Use Permit for the modification of the existing 60' canister flag pole telecommunications tower.

Due to the capacity demands of the T-Mobile network in the general vicinity, new technology will need to be installed on the subject tower. Unfortunately, the equipment is too large for the slim line canister, therefore the antennas must be flush mounted to the monopole

All equipment installed on the tower will be painted to blend into the surroundings with a color that is acceptable to the City of Las Vegas. In addition, removing the canister shroud will allow for additional collocations at this site. The ground equipment is not visible from the street, as it is housed inside the existing commercial center. The existing site is not located within 600 ft. from another communications facility.

The proposed scope of work is: add (3) antennas, add (2) 6x12 hybrids, remove (3) TMAs, add (3) TMAs, add (1) 1/4" coax. The antennas will be flush mounted to the monopole with an anticipated (+/-) 5' standoff.
