Minutes:

COUNCILMAN ROSS declared the Public Hearing open.

TOM PERRIGO, Director of Planning, indicated that staff requested Item 3 be held in abeyance as they had met with downtown businesses who have requested additional time. Staff will propose an amendment to eliminate horse-drawn carriage from Bill No. 2016-50 to come before

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the Council. MR. PERRIGO confirmed for the Committee staff's request for a one month abeyance.

KAREN LAYNE, President of the Las Vegas Valley Humane Society, submitted backup for the record and requested the denial of Bill No. 2016-50 or its portion that addresses horse-drawn carriages. She asked the Committee to instruct MR. PERRIGO to present a proposal which removes sections of the bill pertaining to horse-drawn carriages.

RUSSELL ROWE, who appeared on behalf of Boyd Gaming Corporation and Fremont Street Experience, complimented MR. PERRIGO and staff. MR. ROWE supported and appreciated the abeyance request. MR. PERRIGO added that the 30-day abeyance is supported as it will take staff time to research.

COUNCILMAN ROSS declared the Public Hearing closed.
