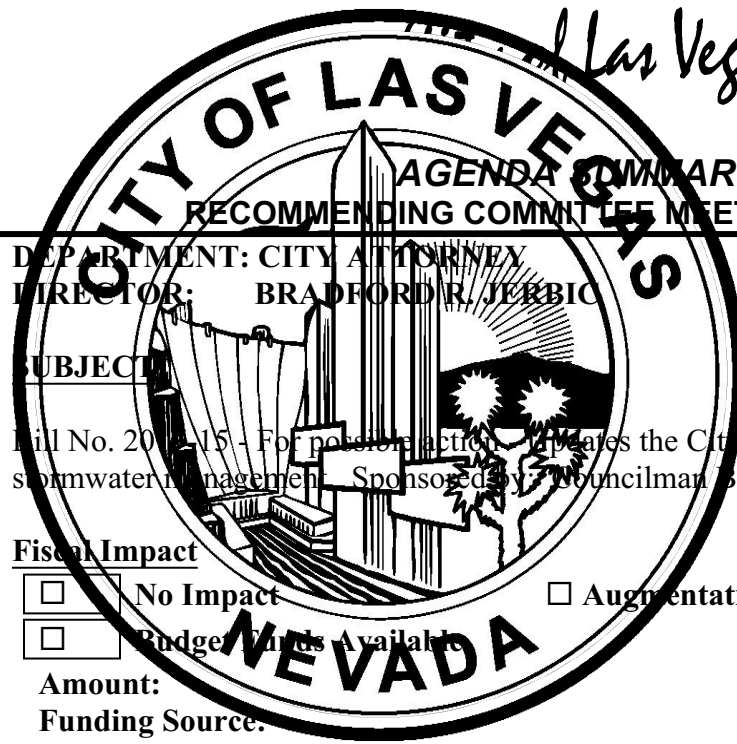

This bill will update the City's regulations governing stormwater and stormwater management. The changes are designed to align Code regulations on the subject with actual practices and with the provisions of the stormwater permit applicable to the City and to the Las Vegas Valley generally.

COUNCILMAN COFFIN declared the Public Hearing open.

DAVID BOWERS, Director of Public Works, stated the proposed bill gives the City the authority to enforce the permit requirements within the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection. Staff has agreed to enforce certain items to ensure stormwater is protected and sediments are not being put into the Las Vegas Wash which ultimately end up in Lake Mead.

COUNCILMAN COFFIN restated that the intent of this bill was to keep the water clean that is going into the storm drains that lead to Lake Mead and then to peoples homes.
