Minutes

The following individuals stated they wanted to speak on the following items: RAY GODFREY for Item 38, JAMES WULFF for Item 58, MICHAEL DYE and JESSE LOPEZ for Item 76, CATHERINE MULKERN, MARY DELUISE, WILLIAM NICOL and THOMAS DINKEL for Item 73, RONALD McNEELY for Item 69 and BRUCE SOARES for Item 83. CHAIR SCHLOTTMAN advised them that these items would be heard during the course of the meeting.

MR. GODFREY requested Item 38 be heard with Item 58 since they involve the same neighborhood. CHAIR SCHLOTTMAN discussed with ASSISTANT CITY ATTORNEY BRYAN SCOTT whether he could take the items out of order, and the Attorney advised him that it was a matter of his discretion.

After MS. DELUISE spoke, ASSISTANT CITY ATTORNEY SCOTT advised that there was no need for individuals to come forward and indicate their desire to speak on an item, and CHAIR SCHLOTTMAN advised them to wait for the respective items as they are considered; however, more individuals came forward to state the item they wanted to speak on.

RONALD McNEELY indicated he wanted to speak on Item 69, and CHAIR SCHLOTTMAN advised him the item was requested to be held in abeyance. For the public records sake, ASSISTANT CITY ATTORNEY SCOTT recommended getting through the housekeeping matters, and then MR. McNEELY could speak since Item 69 was requested to be held.

After MR. DINKEL spoke, CHAIR SCHLOTTMAN reiterated that most of the items stated will be heard and asked that comments be made during the course of the meeting, unless an item was pulled for discussion.

MIKE GANSON, John S. Park Neighborhood resident, requested the items regarding short-term rentals be pulled forward and heard earlier, to which CHAIR SCHLOTTMAN replied that he could not do that because there could be people showing up to speak on them later, given that those items were scheduled on the agenda towards the end.
