Minutes:

DAYVID FIGLER suggested that short-term rentals and related actions could be added to the second Planning Commission agenda of every month. In regard to Code Enforcement and Business Licensing, he believes citizens are concerned about the transparency, accessibility and accuracy of complaints, and that the system is challenged. He recommended that Business Licensing be placed on a future agenda to provide a report on the shortfalls, needs, number of registered complaints and the ratio of the complaints that come before the Planning Commission. He noted that he could not find any of this information online and felt the Planning Commission was a good place to start. Finally, he understood COUNCILWOMAN TARKANIAN was interested in putting a moratorium or end on short-term rentals; however, he felt this was better justified from a legal standpoint.

The meeting was recessed from 8:12 p.m. to 8:25 p.m., from 10:02 p.m. to 10:14 p.m., and adjourned at 12:49 a.m. on July 11, 2018.
