Minutes:

RON POKRYWKA, also known as RON DE CAR, stated that he and the neighborhood are opposed to Item 121 regarding a short-term rental request, and he had previously submitted letters and e-mails. CHAIR CHERRY indicated that application would be heard later in the meeting, but MR. POKRYWKA could submit any documentation at this time if he wished.

CHAIR CHERRY announced that if members of the audience were unable to stay for the meeting they could submit their documentation as well.

JOHN TSITOURAS spoke regarding Item 121 and stated that he lives in the cul-de-sac, and approximately one month ago there was a party at the site. Helicopters and police officers were at the location until 2:00 a.m., and they were telling people to come out with their hands up.

STACIE BROWN, DAVID MENDENHALL and SAM FRIEDMAN each stated they were opposed to Item 121 and requested denial.

MICHAEL GANSON stated that he was opposed to Item 13, and ASSISTANT CITY ATTORNEY BRYAN SCOTT explained that there would be an opportunity to speak on that item when the public hearing was opened.

ADOLPH HILDEBRAND expressed opposition to Item 118, which is a short-term rental request. He stated that the site is right next to a child care center, and CHAIR CHERRY indicated that the Commissioners have all of the maps in their backup.

GENE COLLINS stated that he opposed Item 123 and submitted a protest petition as backup, which has been attached under Item 123.

KELLY LEDESMA and BYRON JONES both expressed opposition to Items 116 and 122.

CHAIR CHERRY confirmed for MARK SCOTT that items on the One Motion One Vote portion of the agenda are public hearing items, and they would be open for public comment. MR. SCOTT expressed interest in Item 14.
