**Minutes:**

MIKE GANSON expressed his concerns with regard to increased traffic in residential neighborhoods. He thought the City needed to come up with a plan or lower the speed limits. Cars should be kept on the main thoroughfares and out of the residential communities or the properties should be made commercial. He did not think the idea of marrying both was working.

COMMISSIONER SCHLOTTMAN thanked CHAIR CHERRY for running an efficient and productive meeting, and he thought the Planning Commission should go back to meeting once a month. He pointed out he spent \$280 of his own money to call in to the Planning Commission meeting last month for two hours when he was in Moorea on Oponohu Bay. Since the meetings were getting shorter and shorter, he did not think there was a need for two meetings a month. COMMISSIONER ROUSH agreed adding holding two meetings a month was a waste of taxpayer dollars and staffs time. She thought the Planning Commission should go back to one meeting a month to be efficient to the budget, taxpayers, citizens and to this body. Additionally, there were a lot of short-term rental applications on the last agenda, and she would be in favor of abeying all short-term rentals until the Council decides what it wants to do.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:24 p.m.
