PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

This bill will amend various provisions of the Municipal Code to regulate the sale, display and consumption of alcoholic beverages, as well as the possession of open containers, within the Downtown Entertainment Overlay District (DEOD). For the most part, the amendments will establish for the DEOD the same regulations that apply to the nearby Pedestrian Mall.

Minutes:

COUNCILMAN ANTHONY declared the Public Hearing open.

MARY McELHONE, Deputy Planning Director, reported that a few years ago the license code was changed regarding off-sale liquor as to what could be sold in off-sale locations. A requirement was imposed for off-sale purchases to be bagged with a fastener and a sales receipt affixed to the bag. This bill extends those requirements to the Downtown Overlay District, which

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is basically East Fremont Street from Las Vegas Boulevard to 8th Street. Staff was noticing visitors were bringing in coolers of alcoholic beverages on East Fremont Street and drinking openly. This will prevent that activity and enable the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department to issue citations.

COUNCILMAN ANTHONY announced that the bill would go to the 11/21/2018 City Council meeting for consideration.

COUNCILMAN ANTHONY declared the Public Hearing closed.
