PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

This bill will amend various provisions of the Unified Development Code (Title 19) to authorize as a home occupation the breeding of domestic dogs and cats under specified circumstances. The bill is necessitated by (and a follow-up to) the ordinance passed earlier this year that requires dog and cat breeders to obtain a business license.

COUNCILMAN ANTHONY declared the Public Hearing open.

PETER LOWENSTEIN, Deputy Planning Director, stated that the bill places breeding within home occupation section of the code. Individuals with existing animal handling licenses would be allowed to breed dogs and cats through a home occupation permit. The use must comply with animal control regulations.

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COUNCILMAN ANTHONY announced that the bill would go to the 11/21/2018 City Council meeting for consideration.
