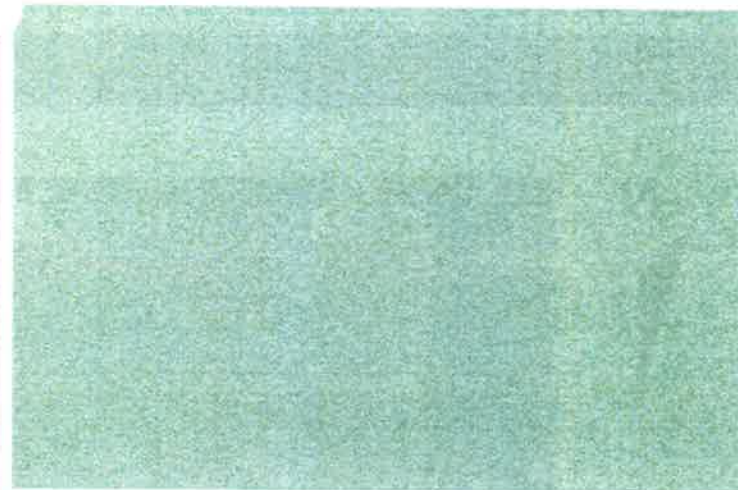

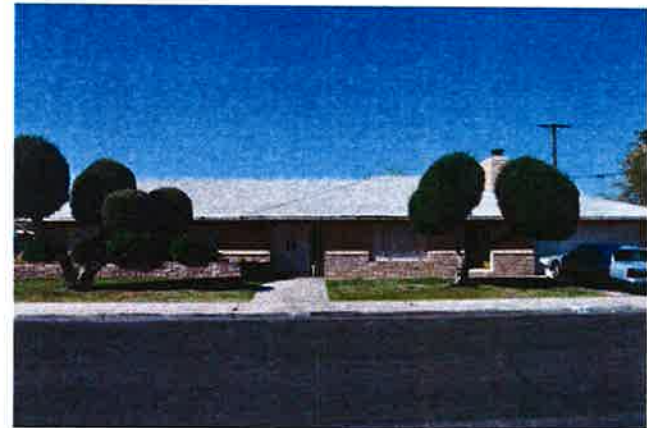

Impacts to Property Owners

- Designated on the local register
- Any work requiring a building or zoning permit is reviewed by staff and/or the HPC
- No fees for HPC review
- Appeal period
- Designation runs with the land
- Eligible for small HPC bricks and mortar matching grants





State and National Registers

- Three types of historic designation: “Local” (CLV Historic Property Register), state and national
- Local listing *protects* through ordinance
- National and state listings *identify* historically significant properties
- No HPC review required
- No additional fees or property taxes
- 182 properties listed on the local register
- 565 properties on the state and national registers
