

RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE MAYOR'S DECLARATION ENDING THE COVID-19 STATE OF EMERGENCY, DIRECTING THE DEACTIVATION OF THE CITY'S EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PLAN, AND REPEALING RESOLUTION R-13-2020 RELATED TO SEEKING ASSISTANCE AND RESOURCES IN CONNECTION WITH THE PREVIOUS STATE OF EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Las Vegas has declared an end to the state of emergency related to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it appropriate to ratify that action and to take other steps consistent with that action.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS to:

1. Ratify the Mayor's action referred to above;
2. Direct the deactivation of the City's emergency management plan;
3. Terminate the emergency-related powers granted to the City Manager in connection with the previous state of emergency; and
4. Repeal Resolution R-13-2020 related to seeking assistance and resources in connection with the previous state of emergency.


