3 AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT THE 2018 EDITION OF THE INTERNATIONAL ENERGY
4 CONSERVATION CODE, TOGETHER WITH AMENDMENTS THERETO, AND TO PROVIDE FOR
OTHER RELATED MATTERS.

Summary: Adopts the 2018 Edition of the
International Energy Conservation Code, together
with amendments thereto.

7 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS
8 FOLLOWS:

9 SECTION 1: Title 16, Chapter 52, Section 10, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las
10 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

11 **16.52.010:** Those certain documents, three copies of which are on file in the Office of the City Clerk
12 and are designated as follows, are adopted by reference as if set forth herein in full:

13 (A) The publication entitled “International Energy Conservation Code, [2009] 2018
14 Edition,” as published by the International Code Council, as Part 1 of this Chapter; and

15 (B) The document entitled “Southern Nevada Amendments to the [2009] 2018
16 International Energy Conservation Code,” which adds to, deletes from and amends the “International
17 Energy Conservation Code, [2009] 2018 Edition,” as Part 2 of this Chapter.

18 SECTION 2: The document entitled “Southern Nevada Amendments to the 2018
19 International Energy Conservation Code” is attached hereto.

20 SECTION 3: Ordinance Nos. 6069, 6144 and 6256, as well as the 2009 International
21 Energy Conservation Code and the Southern Nevada Amendments to the 2009 International Energy
22 Conservation Code, are hereby repealed in their entirety.

23 SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be effective as of February 4, 2019.

24 SECTION 5: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase
25 in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by
26 any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the

1 remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas hereby
2 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase
3 thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs,
4 sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

5 SECTION 6: Whenever in this ordinance any act is prohibited or is made or declared to
6 be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, or whenever in this ordinance the doing of any act is required
7 or the failure to do any act is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, the doing of
8 such prohibited act or the failure to do any such required act shall constitute a misdemeanor and upon
9 conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000.00 or by imprisonment for a term of
10 not more than six months, or by any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Any day of any violation
11 of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

12 SECTION 7: All ordinances or parts of ordinances or sections, subsections, phrases,
13 sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983
14 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
