AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND LVMC CHAPTER 2.44 TO ADD A NEW SECTION ESTABLISHING MEETING-RELATED REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PLANNING COMMISSION, AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER RELATED MATTERS.

Proposed by: Scott D. Adams, City Manager Summary: Amends LVMC Chapter 2.44 to add a new section establishing meeting-related requirements for the Planning Commission.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 2, Chapter 44, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section, designated as Section 50, reading as follows:

2.44.050: (A) The Planning Commission shall hold at least one regular meeting each month. From time to time the City Council may approve regular meeting schedules with a greater meeting frequency. The approval of such schedules shall be based on input and recommendation from the Director of Planning, taking into account the amount and nature of business to be conducted.

(B) Subject to the provisions of Subsection (A), the scheduling of regular meetings and other meetings shall be as set forth in the rules or bylaws that have been adopted by the Planning Commission pursuant to State law.

SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.
