PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

The Nevada Community Redevelopment Law (NRS 279.454) requires any officer or employee of the City who participates in the formulation of or approval of plans or policies for a redevelopment area to disclose any direct or indirect financial interest he/she has in said property; and, if any officer or employee owns, purchases or acquires any interest in such property, they shall make a written disclosure of said interest on the minutes of both the City Council and the Redevelopment Agency.

Minutes:

LUANN D. HOLMES, City Clerk, stated this is the annual disclosure of interest in the Redevelopment Areas as required by Nevada Revised Statute 279.454. Any officer or employee of the City, who in the course of their duties participates in the formulation or approval of plans or policies in either of the two redevelopment areas in the city, must disclose any direct or indirect interest in said properties.

She stated the law requires these disclosures be entered into the record of the Redevelopment Agency as well as the City Council meeting. This item, along with City Council Item 15 on the mornings Consent Agenda, satisfies that requirement. MS. HOLMES indicated no action was required on this item.
