The following conditions are repeated until they are complete:

1. Since the street and the associated storm drain facilities will eventually be accepted by the **City of Las Vegas**, the engineer/developer must coordinate with *City of Las Vegas Streets & Sanitation Department* for their review and approval prior to the final acceptance of the subject improvement plans.
2. All offsite interim flood control facilities such as but not limited to berms / ditches and temporary sump are privately owned and to be privately maintained by the *Howard Hughes Company*.
3. Add a note in all pertinent sheets for the construction of all storm drain drop inlets per USDCCA Drawing No. 421 (*Stormwater Quality Management Stamp and Sign Detail*).

**NOTE:** Any future changes to the proposed design (or design assumptions) as outlined in the approved drainage study and attached preliminary grading plan which affect drainage must be addressed in a Drainage Study Update and accepted by the *City of Las Vegas Flood Control Section*. Additionally, conditional acceptance of a drainage study is valid for a period of one (1) year. If the proposed construction has not been completed in that time period, the *City of Las Vegas* reserves the right to require additional conditions and/or submission and acceptance of a complete drainage study update prior to further construction of a project.

**NOTE:** Please be advised that all land surface area disturbances over 1 acre or any area adjacent to a water way must submit to the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection a "Notice of Intent" to discharge that certifies a stormwater pollution prevention plan has been developed and is maintained on site; for inclusion in the Stormwater General Permit No. NVR100000. A phased construction unit in a contiguous subdivision is considered under construction until all stripped or disturbed surface areas have been covered by paving, building construction or planting. Oh-Sang, as discussed, attached are the two requests for Interim Diversion Berm Bond releases, where the letters have been modified as requested to incorporate the current developer's improvement bond #'s etc. Please process and send the release letters to the above CC's.

Also as discussed and follow up, the two other requests for Interim Diversion bond releases for Village 21 Parcels E & F and Parcel I will not be released or partially released, as the interim berms for each set of HHC improvements extend beyond and incorporate interim berms in other parcels besides E&F and I, and they have to stay in place until those parcels develop., as City Building Department does not want to do partial releases as they are hard to keep track of.

After thinking about that over the weekend, we originally set up the interim diversion berm bonds with clear exhibits and costs for the interim berms for each developer parcel the interim berm existed. This was done clearly with the intent of being able to release portions of the interim diversion berms that would be replaced by Developer onsite improvements, and HHC would be still responsible to maintain the remaining interim diversion berms until that parcel develops. That remaining interim diversion berm bond could easily be tied to the undeveloped assessor parcel.

Since our discussion, can we set up a follow up conference call that includes building department

Michael, as discussed with Oh-Sang Kwon, this letter and attachments are to request that the CLV release the following Interim Diversion Berm Maintenance Bond for Village 21 Parcels A (Assessor Parcel 137-26-212-001) & B (Assessor parcel 137-26-212-002), which was required as result of the Village 21 Carriage Hill Improvement design by VTN (CLV Plan # L18-00888, DS-4962C). The above parcels have been sold to Woodside Homes, and based on site visit and observation, Parcels A & B have been fully graded, with models under construction. The interim diversion berms along the west side of Carriage Hill no longer physically exist or are required. Woodside has had to post an improvement bond for their on-site construction, therefore the separate Interim Diversion Berm Maintenance Bond # SU57509 in the amount of \$219,400 should be released.

These Interim drainage improvements have been replaced by the Village 21 Parcel A7B Improvements (L20-01211 & DS-5222)
