Hey Albert

We are just about to get concurrence on the Lamb and Owens project, and CCPW asked that I contact you concerning a revision to the calcs that we made in the response to CCPW comments.

Per a comment on the CCPW comment letter I've added a new drainage basin at the entrance of the site at Owens. It's shown on Figure 7 of the attached addendum study. The new basin placed 2 cfs in the Owens alignment. The flows continue downstream until they hit Vegasgreen Trail and then they turn south onto Vegasgreen Trail.

I looked at the Cross Section Table on Figure 7 and the information for Section X was not update for Addendum 3. The cross section in the appendix used for the flow split is 475 cfs with the additional 2 cfs. I've bookmarked the location in the appendix to make things easier. This raised the WSEL by 0.01 feet. I don't believe that this would actually be a peak-to-peak addition though. Unfortunately, I don't have the hydrograph for the Owens flowrate to prove it.

I've attached a copy of the Addendum 3 letter, and a copy of the Addendum 2 Figure 7 for your review. In-any-event CCPW asked that I make you aware of this to see if you needed additional information for your files.
