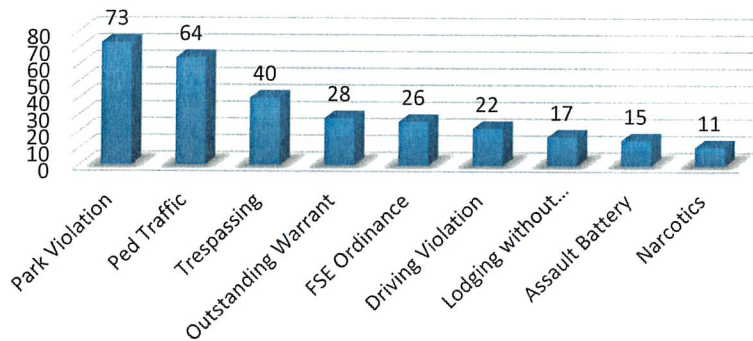

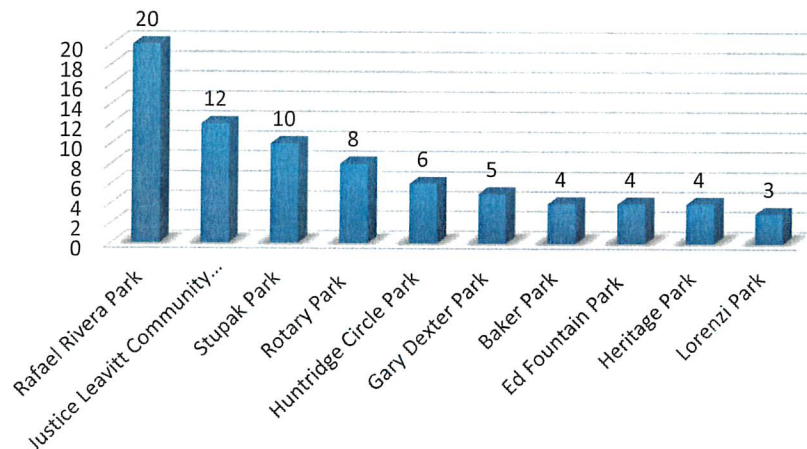

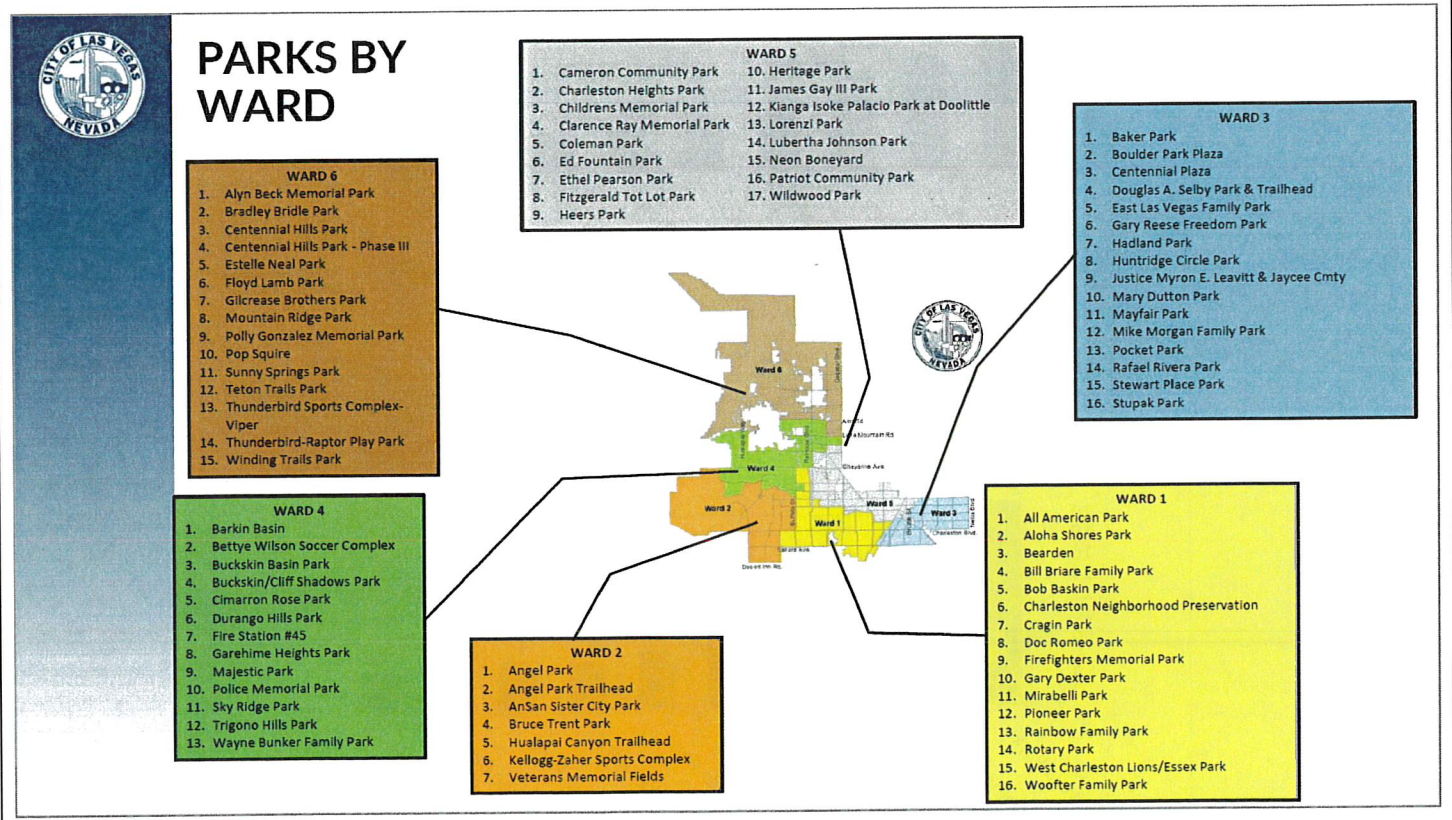
MULTI-AGENCY OUTREACH ENGAGEMENT TEAM (MORE TEAM)

COMMUNITY HEALTH / STREETS AND SANITATION

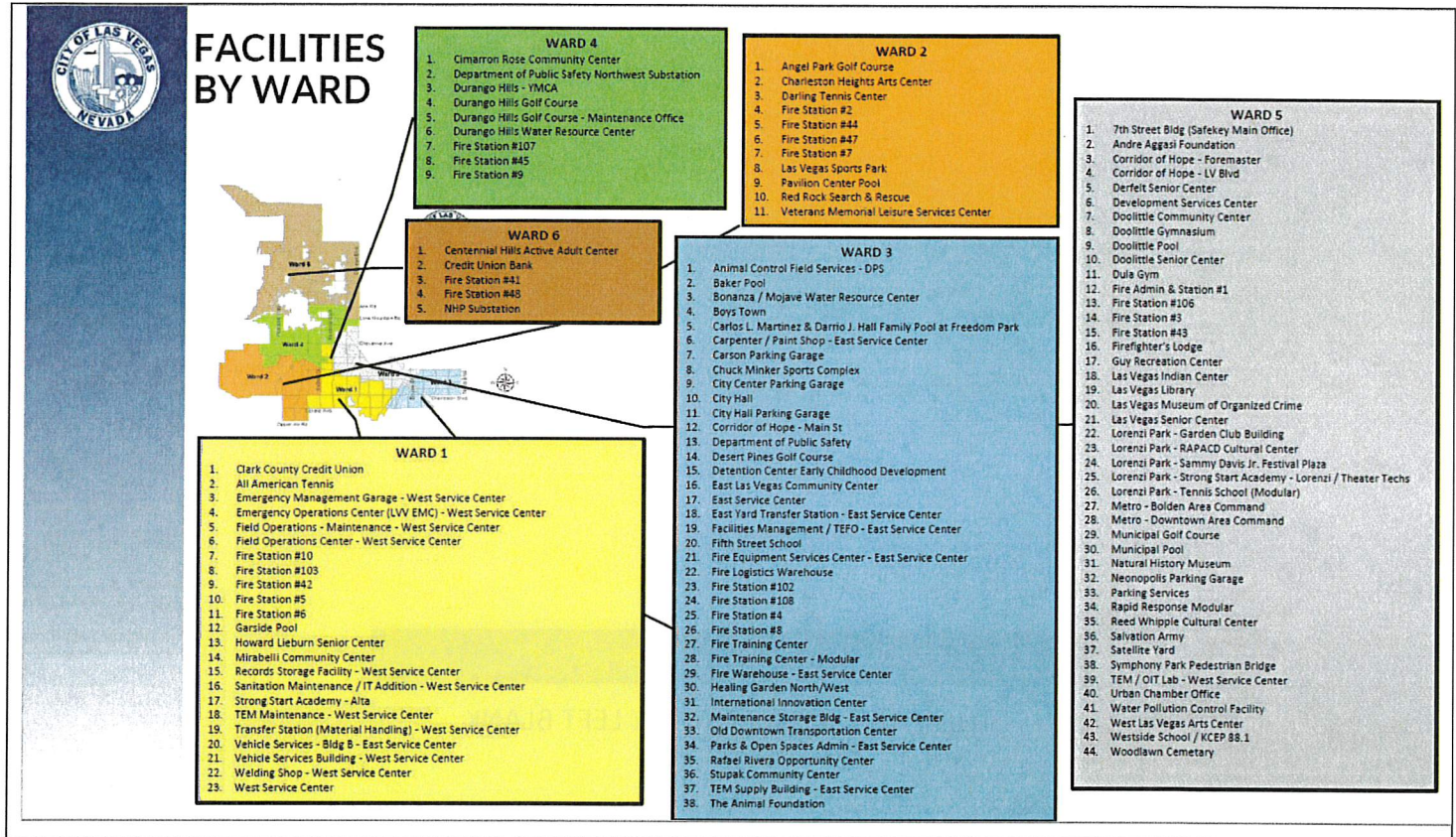
