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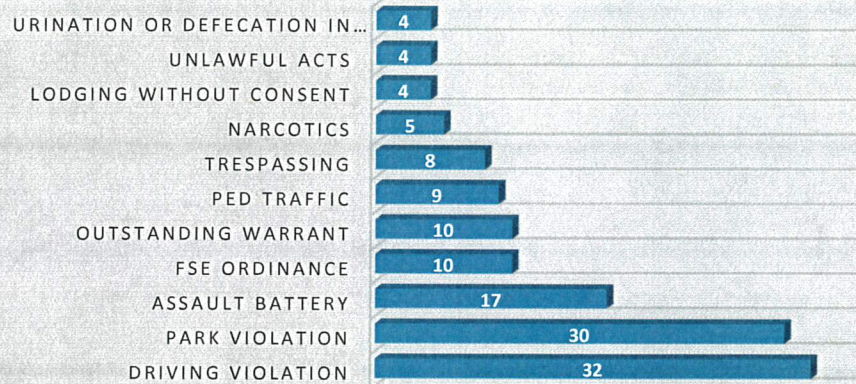

MULTI-AGENCY OUTREACH ENGAGEMENT TEAM (MORE TEAM)		
The Deputy City Marshals' MORE Team collectively made contact with 213 individuals for outreach engagement. Of the 213 individuals contacted, 124 accepted services and 89 declined services.
