ABEYANCE ITEM: DISCUSSION FOR POSSIBLE ACTION OR APPEAL OF STAFF DECISION TO NOT INSTALL SPEED CUSHIONS ON FRANKLIN AVENUE BETWEEN MARYLAND PARKWAY AND 15TH STREET – WARD 3 (COFFIN)

BACKGROUND

At its meeting on March 28, 2019 the Traffic and Parking Commission discussed the request for speed humps on Franklin Avenue between Maryland Parkway and 15th Street. Franklin Avenue is a primary emergency response route.

The Transportation Engineering Division conducted a study of Franklin Avenue and concluded that speed humps were not appropriate. One of the measures used for consideration of speed humps is an 85th percentile speed greater than 35 mph. The most recent speeds measured on Franklin Avenue show that the 85th percentile speed is 30 mph, which is below the recommended criteria. For this reason and because Franklin Avenue is a primary emergency response route, the City Transportation Division recommended denial of speed humps.

The Traffic and Parking Commission is requesting clarification from the Fire Department regarding their support of the installation of speed cushions whenever speed hump criteria is not met on emergency response routes. This item was abeyed for further discussion until the next Traffic and Parking Commission meeting.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

The Traffic Engineering Division recommends denial of installing speed cushions on Franklin Avenue between Maryland Parkway and 15th Street.
