BACKGROUND

At its meeting on April 25, 2019 the Traffic and Parking Commission discussed the request for speed cushions on Franklin Avenue between Maryland Parkway and 15th Street and a motion was made to approve the speed cushions on Franklin Avenue subject to staff's consultation with the neighborhood and determination of final placement, both to be presented at a subsequent meeting.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

The Traffic Engineering Division recommends to install speed cushions on Franklin Avenue between Maryland Parkway and 15th Street.

Jan 2016_ Collected volume and speeds (809 vpd and average speed = 26 mph)

Jan 2018_ Collected volume and speeds (959 vpd and average speed = 33 mph)

Dec 2018_ Centerline and parking lane lines installed

Feb 2019_ Collected volume and speeds (1220 vpd and average speed= 22 mph)

May 14, 2019 _ Mailed 43 surveys to property owners/residents. We received 11 responses, all 11 approved the installation of speed cushions.

DISCUSSION FOR POSSIBLE ACTION TO INSTALL SPEED HUMPS ON SHETLAND ROAD BETWEEN PINTO LANE AND ALTA DRIVE – WARD 1 (KNUDSEN)

BACKGROUND

During discussion of Item #38 at the April 17, 2019, City Council Meeting, the applicant requested installation of speed humps on Shetland Road, between Alta Drive and Pinto Lane. It was noted that speed humps were not on the agenda for discussion, therefore, this issue should go through the typical process and be heard for discussion at the Traffic and Parking Commission.

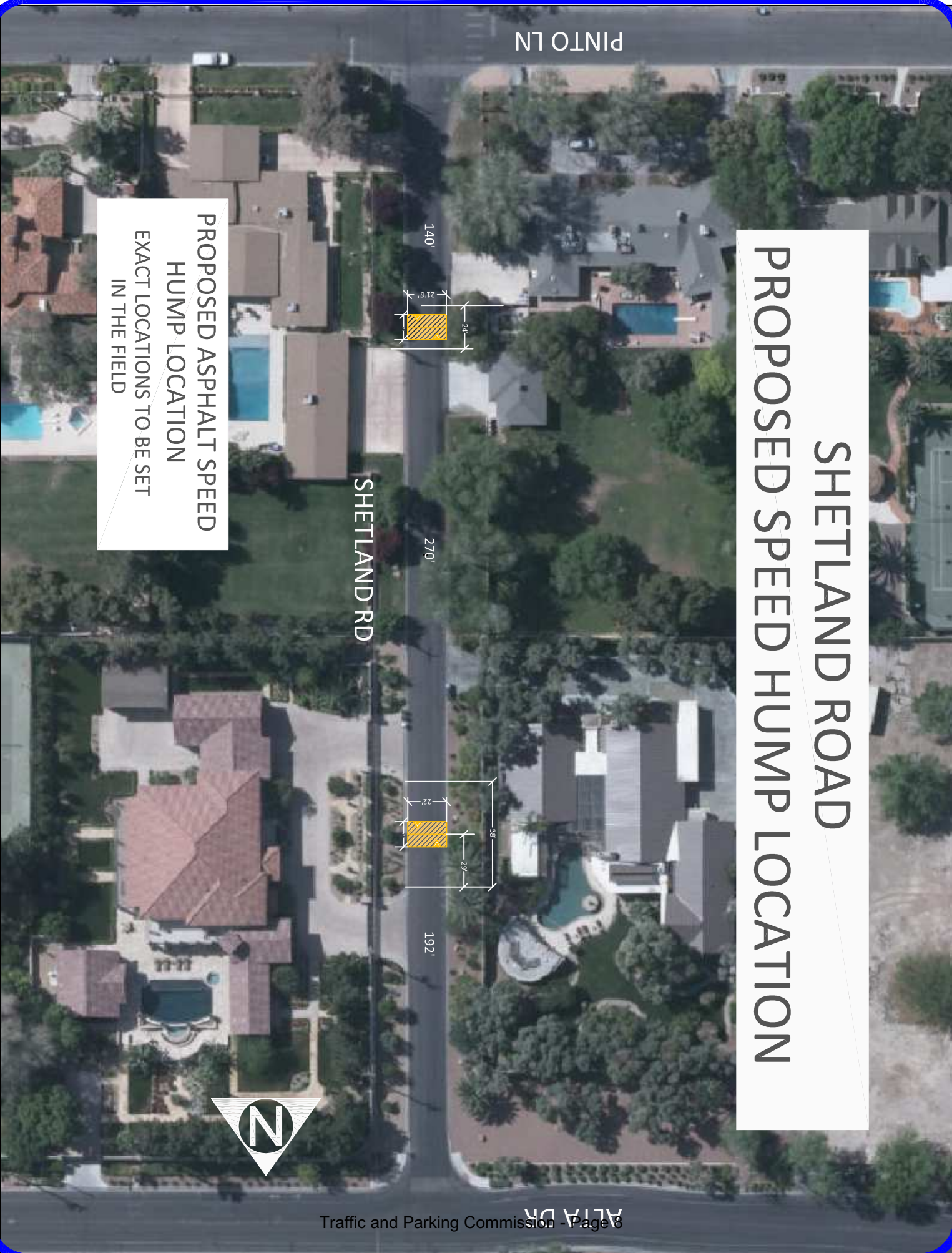
Traffic data was collected, with the average daily traffic volume on this section of Shetland Road measured at 784 vehicles per day and an average speed of 29 mph. There is no reported crash history. Although there is no apparent traffic safety issue, there are speed humps on other streets in the neighborhood. Therefore, because this application of speed humps is supported by CLV Fire & Rescue and is consistent with other similarly-classed streets in the neighborhood, staff supports the installation of speed humps on Shetland Road.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

The Traffic Engineering Division recommends installation of speed humps on Shetland Road between Pinto Lane and Alta Drive.
