Bill No. 2021-9 - For possible action - Amends the Town Center Development Standards Manual, adopted under LVMC 19.10.060(B), by amending Map Six thereof, pertaining to street classifications, to remove the designation of Echelon Point Drive as a Town Center Collector. Speaking to the proposed First Amendment, DEPUTY CITY ATTORNEY JEFF DOROCAK, explained Line 19 that currently reads Bath Drive between Tee Pee Lane and the Campbell Road/Kingston Bay Street alignment will be changed to Bath Drive between Tee Pee Lane and North Durango Drive.

4. Bill No. 2021-10 - For possible action - Amends the Town Center Development Standards Manual to allow for animated signs within nonresidential districts, subject to specified limitations and restrictions. Sponsored by: Councilwoman Michele Fiore

PETER LOWENSTEIN, Deputy Director of Planning, explained this bill is intended to reflect changes in technology and advertising practices while maintaining the appropriate limitations. It differentiates between changeable copying and animated signage, whereas animated signage will be subject to a Master Sign Plan application followed by a public hearing. Staff recommended approval.

COUNCILMAN ANTHONY clarified that this was not the Masterplan 2050 and Imagine Parks LV Meeting, which was currently reflected on the broadcast.

COUNCILMAN ANTHONY declared the Public Hearing closed.
