1. Call to Order

2. Announcement Regarding: Compliance with Open Meeting Law

3. Bill No. 2019-49 - For possible action - Amends various provisions of the Unified Development Code to establish "City communication sign" as a subcategory of off-premise sign and establish the parameters under which such signs are allowed. Sponsored by: Mayor Carolyn G. Goodman

Minutes:

COUNCILMAN ANTHONY declared the Public Hearing open.

ROBERT SUMMERFIELD, Director of Planning, reported that this bill would add provisions to create a new subcategory of off-premise sign called City communications. This will add that language to the Civic District, specifically allowing a City communications sign to be approved within a civic district without out meeting the SUP (Special Use Permit) requirements an off-premise sign would normally require. It also adds an exception to the Scenic Byway that if all other qualifications are met for a City communications sign, such a sign could be within the Byway. The Permitted Uses Table was reorganized to provide for this new category as an off-premise sign qualifying as City communication. Language was also added to SUP provisions to address the exemption for the City communication sign concept. Additionally, because there was not a definition for this new concept, that has been added into the Definitions chapter.

MR. SUMMERFIELD explained that this is a new concept as outlined in the code, but not for the City. City communications signs have existed for a while under the heading of the parquee program, but they were treated as standard off-premise signs and were required to go through that process and meet those requirements.

COUNCILMAN ANTHONY declared the Public Hearing closed.

Subsequent to the motion and the vote, COUNCILMAN ANTHONY announced that this bill will be eligible for adoption at the January 15, 2020 City Council meeting.
