

The revision to the drainage study was submitted via email to the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) for concurrence on October 5, 2021. In addition, the BLM has received the City of Las Vegas acceptance letter dated September 20, 2021, for the Technical Drainage Study Update #1 (DS5169D).
