DISCUSSION

SUBJECT:

Bill No. 2023-16 - For possible action - Readopts LVMC 10.02.010 to make State misdemeanors City misdemeanors if committed within the City. Proposed by: Bryan K. Scott, City Attorney

FISCAL IMPACT:

None

PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:

Pursuant to LVMC 10.02.010, any offense that constitutes a misdemeanor under State law is also a misdemeanor under City law if it is committed within the corporate boundaries of the City. This permits prosecution of such an offense in Municipal Court. In order to assure that LVMC 10.02.010 is interpreted to incorporate State-law changes made during the 82nd Session of the Nevada Legislature, LVMC 10.02.010 should be readopted. This bill will accomplish that objective.

RECOMMENDATION:

This bill should be submitted to a Recommending Committee for review, hearing and recommendation to the City Council for final action.

AN ORDINANCE TO READOPT LVMC 10.02.010, THE MUNICIPAL CODE PROVISION MAKING STATE-LAW MISDEMEANORS CITY MISDEMEANORS IF COMMITTED WITHIN THE CITY.

Proposed by: Bryan K. Scott, City Attorney

Summary: Readopts LVMC 10.02.010 to make State misdemeanors City misdemeanors if committed within the City.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Las Vegas declares that any offense made a misdemeanor by the laws of the State of Nevada shall also be a misdemeanor in the City of Las Vegas whenever such offense is committed within the boundaries of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reaffirmed that declaration by means of the adoption of LVMC 10.02.010; and

WHEREAS, a number of criminal laws were enacted or amended by the Nevada Legislature during its 82nd Session, some of which became effective upon passage and approval, and others of which become effective on October 1, 2023, or on some other date specified within those laws; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires by this Ordinance to readopt LVMC 10.02.010 to include within its purview, to the extent affirmative action to do so is necessary, all the State misdemeanor laws which have been enacted by the Nevada State Legislature.

NOW, THEREFORE, BASED UPON THE FOREGOING, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:
