The Planning Commission at a regular meeting held on *September 12, 2023* voted to **APPROVE** a request FOR A PROPOSED FREESTANDING SIGN WITH ANIMATED LED DISPLAY AT AN EXISTING PUBLIC PRIMARY SCHOOL on 8.79 acres at 6451 Brandywine Way (APN 138-35-301-001), C-V (Civic) Zone, Ward 1 (Knudsen).

This approval is subject to the following conditions:


Planning

1. This approval shall be void two years from the date of final approval, unless exercised pursuant to the provisions of LVMC Title 19.16. An Extension of Time may be filed for consideration by the City of Las Vegas.
2. All development shall be in conformance with the site plan and sign elevations date stamped 07/24/23.
3. Any future amendments to the approved signage within the Master Sign Plan in conformance with the Master Sign Plan and new signage in conformance with Title 19 standards may be reviewed and approved administratively by the Department of Community Development.
4. Animated signs containing a changeable electronic message shall consist of static images that have a minimum duration of six seconds for each message. The transition time between each message shall be no more than two seconds with no motion or animation during the transition between messages.

5. Animated signs containing a changeable electronic message utilizing LED illumination shall adjust brightness automatically in response to changes in surrounding light levels so as not to be unreasonably bright. At no time shall the brightness of LED illumination exceed 300 nits.
6. All City Code requirements and design standards of all City departments must be satisfied, except as modified herein.

This action by the Planning Commission on **September 12, 2023** is final unless a written appeal is filed with the City Clerk within ten days of the date of the Planning Commission's decision as allowed by code or there is a review action filed by the City Council within the same time period. No building permits or business licenses related to these items shall be issued prior to the expiration of the required ten day waiting period, or until any filed appeal is resolved pursuant to LVMC Title 19.18.
