

RESOLUTION DESIGNATING ROTARY PARK AS A CHILDREN’S PARK

WHEREAS, LVMC Chapter 13.36 is concerned with the administration and regulation of City parks;

and

WHEREAS, LVMC 13.36.150 authorizes the establishment and regulation of children’s parks, which are parks intended primarily for the use of children twelve years of age or younger; and

WHEREAS, as part of its focus on the preservation of neighborhoods, the City Council believes it is important to have parks within the community that provide a safe and comfortable recreational environment for children; and

WHEREAS, Rotary Park, located at 901 Hinson Street, is located in an established neighborhood, including both residential and commercial properties; and

WHEREAS, the present environment found in Rotary Park includes security concerns that are inconsistent with the use and enjoyment of the park by children; and

WHEREAS, because of the location of Rotary Park and its proximity to a middle school, the City Council finds it in the interest of the public health, safety, and welfare to designate Rotary Park as a children’s park; and

WHEREAS, except as otherwise provided in this Resolution, the designation of Rotary Park as a children’s park will have the effect of making the park subject to all the provisions of LVMC Chapter 13.36 that govern children’s parks.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, pursuant to and in accordance with LVMC 13.36.150, as follows:

1. Rotary Park, located at 901 Hinson Street, is designated as a children’s park.
2. The provisions of LVMC Chapter 13.36 that govern children’s parks shall apply to Rotary Park, except as modified below:

- A. The applicable age limit is 14 years of age or younger.

- B. Employees of the Clark County School District are authorized to be in the park during and in connection with school activities that the City has authorized to be conducted in the park, including

1 gatherings associated with fire drills.
