

2 **RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE 2024 CLARK COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL**
3 **HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN**

4 WHEREAS, the City of Las Vegas participated in the development and implementation of a multi-
5 jurisdictional hazard mitigation plan (Mitigation Plan) in 2018 pursuant to the requirement of the federal
6 Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, to submit a plan that identifies potential hazards, risks, and vulnerabilities
7 which cause loss of property and life, economic hardship, and other threats to public health and safety; and

8 WHEREAS, the 2018 mitigation plan was adopted by the City Council at the March 7, 2018,
9 meeting, and the Mitigation Plan was submitted to the State of Nevada and the Federal Emergency
10 Management Agency (FEMA); and

11 WHEREAS, to maintain eligibility for federal disaster assistance, the Mitigation Plan has been
12 updated in 2024 by representatives from Clark County, City of Las Vegas and other local jurisdictions,
13 including special districts within Clark County for the reduction of hazardous risk within our communities;
14 and

15 WHEREAS, the 2024 Mitigation Plan identifies and recommends hazard mitigation actions and
16 projects that include processes that will minimize or eliminate the impact of natural, man-made, and
17 technological hazards, and

18 WHEREAS, a public comment period was provided for review of the 2024 Mitigation Plan as
19 required by law.


20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS
21 VEGAS, NEVADA as follows:

- 22 1. The 2024 Mitigation Plan, which is on file with the City Clerk, is hereby adopted as an official plan of the
23 City of Las Vegas and supersedes and replaces the 2018 Clark County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation
24 Plan.
- 25 2. The respective officials identified in the mitigation strategy of the 2024 Mitigation Plan are hereby directed
26 to pursue implementation of the recommended actions assigned to such officials, subject to funding for such


- 1 actions being duly authorized.
- 2 3. The 2024 Mitigation Plan will be updated as and when required by the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000
- 3 and FEMA.
- 4 4. Reports on the progress of the implementation elements of the 2024 Mitigation Plan shall be provided
- 5 upon request of the Las Vegas City Council.
