12 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS
13 FOLLOWS:

14 SECTION 1: The City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby grants to Google Fiber Nevada,
15 LLC, the non-exclusive right, privilege, authority and permission to install, operate and maintain
16 communications services, including broadband internet service and/or telecommunications service, in, upon,
17 along, across, above, over and under all present and future public ways (excluding railroad rights-of-way),
18 highways, streets, avenues and alleys within the corporate limits of the City of Las Vegas, subject to and in
19 accordance with the terms and conditions of the Franchise Agreement between the City of Las Vegas and
20 Google Fiber Nevada, LLC, a copy of which Franchise Agreement is on file with the Clerk of the City of
21 Las Vegas and by this reference incorporated herein. For the purposes of this Section, the term
22 “telecommunications service” has the meaning of that term as defined in the United States Code at 47 U.S.C.
23 §153(53), and the term “broadband internet service” means “broadband internet access service” as described
24 in 47 C.F.R. § 8.1(b).

25 SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase
26 in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by

1 any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the
2 remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas hereby
3 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase
4 thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs,
5 sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.


6 SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances or sections, subsections, phrases,
7 sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983
8 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

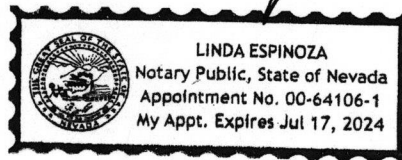

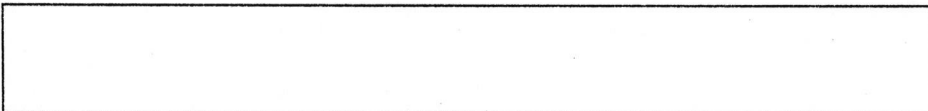

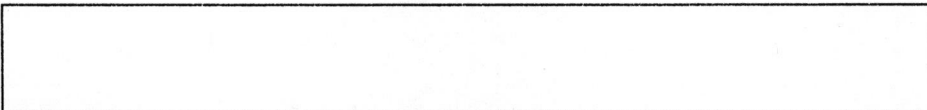
